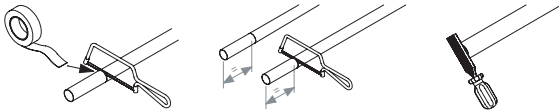


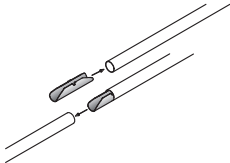
Step 3 - Reducing length of pole:

If necessary, to reduce the length of the pole, you will need to cut the pole. Use masking tape if possible to avoid damage. When using two poles, cut equal lengths from each pole. File sharp edges to avoid injury or damage to other components.

Note: Ensure cut side of pole is used for finial end.



When using two poles, join them by sliding a joining piece **inside** the first pole(uncut end) then slide the joining piece **inside** the uncut end of the second pole. Take care to push an equal length of the joiner into each pole. The pole joints should always be at the half way point of the installation length and supported with a bracket. Note: The pole joiner MUST NOT be fitted outside the poles
