

Radiator Cover Care Guide

Before fitting your radiator cover, check that it's safe to partially cover your radiator.

Direct sunlight can affect the colour of your radiator cover. We recommend avoiding strong sunlight as much as possible and periodically moving items placed on the radiator cover to allow the colour to fade evenly.

Always lift your radiator cover into place - dragging it across the floor could damage the floor and the cover. To protect wooden or laminate floors in particular, make sure the plastic or felt protectors are secure and stay in place.

Use a damp cloth and mild detergent when cleaning, don't use bleach or any abrasive cleaning products. Dust regularly with a soft, lint-free cloth.

Don't use abrasive or silicone-based polishes - they can affect the finish of your cover. Patch test polishes in a hidden area.
