The Next Step...

There is no need to feel daunted by the number of parts and fittings in front of you, we have compiled this straight forward, step-by-step guide to make sure that assembling your furniture is as easy as 1, 2, 3.

Before you begin, we advise that you check that you have everything you need to get started.

TOP TIP

Find a space to spread everything out across the floor before you begin assembling the item. Lay each panel down on a clean and level area, ideally in the room of intended use, ensuring there is enough room to manoeuvre around the item. It is recommended that two people assemble this product together.

The full list of furniture parts, fixtures and fittings, as well as the tools you will need for assembly can be found on page 2 of this manual.

TOP TIP

Identify all of the fittings, make sure that you have them all prepared and familiarise yourself with each component, to make things easier when you are putting it all together.

Safety and Care Advice

IMPORTANT - The first step you need to take is to ensure your safety!

Please take the time to read and understand these instructions before assembling your furniture.

Please keep these instructions for future reference.

Keep children and animals away from the assembly area.

This furniture contains small parts that could cause choking if swallowed.

Keep all plastic wrapping materials away from babies and children to avoid danger of suffocation.

Ensure that all packaging is disposed of carefully and responsibly.

From time to time check that there are no loose fittings on the unit, re-tighten when necessary.

Two people may be required for the assembly of this product.

Once items are part or fully assembled they are not returnable unless faulty.


This item is not for outdoor use – unless stated otherwise.

Some items will be supplied with a wall fixing strap, which we recommend is used to secure the item to the wall, to prevent a child from accidentally pulling furniture over.




Parts - exploded view




Parts - plan view




1 Backrest

3 Front Leg




4 Side Rail x 2




5 Stretcher x 2









Before you start


Check the pack and make sure you have all the parts listed above.


Follow this step-by-step guide

Step 1: Insert wood dowels (F) into holes on the side rails (4) as shown.



Step 2: Place the front leg (3) on a flat protected surface. Position the siderails (4) as shown and insert the wood dowels into holes on the front leg. Then fix using bolts (A), spring washers (D) and flat washers (E).


Important note: Fasten bolts using the allen key H) but do not fully tighten at this stage. Use oval head of allen key when tightening bolts on corner positions.


Step 3: Place the backrest (1) on a flat protected surface. Position the stretcher (5) as shown and insert into the hole on the backrest.


Step 4: Then align and insert the stretchers (5) into holes on the front leg (3). Position the siderails (4) as shown and insert the wood dowel into center holes on backrest (1).


Step 5: Fix the backrest (1) to siderail (4) using bolts (A), spring washers (D) and flat washers (E).
Important note: Fasten bolts using the allen key (H) but do not fully tighten at this stage. Use oval head of allen key when tightening bolts on corner positions.


Step 6: Carefully turn the chair upright and place on a flat surface. Make adjustments to ensure the chair frame is straight and the legs are even on the floor then fully tighten all bolts assembled in previous steps using the allen key (H).

Step 7: Secure the stretchers (5) to the backrest (1) and front leg (3) using screws (B). Tighten screws using a crosshead screwdriver.

Step 8: Carefully place the seat (2) face down on a raised protected surface. Seat (2) should be centrally positioned with the frame of the stool and screwed in using screws (C) and brackets (G). Tighten screws using a crosshead screwdriver.

Care and maintenance

Wood

Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

Wood is a natural product and each piece is individual. The colour will mellow over time and new items can vary in shade from items that you have already purchased. We also recommend that any ornaments, coasters and items placed on the product are periodically moved around to allow the colour to mellow evenly.

As a natural product, wood is affected by temperature and humidity. We recommend that you avoid placing the furniture directly in front of heat sources such as radiators or fires as this can cause cracking or warping over time. Always use matts and coasters to protect the surface when placing items on the furniture. This will help to protect the finish from heat, liquids or items that might scratch your furniture.

Remove any spills immediately to avoid staining. Dust regularly with a soft lint free cloth or duster.

The use of abrasive polish or silicon based polishes is not advised as these can affect the polished finish and joints over time. Always lift your furniture into place, avoid dragging it across the floor as this can cause damage to joints.
