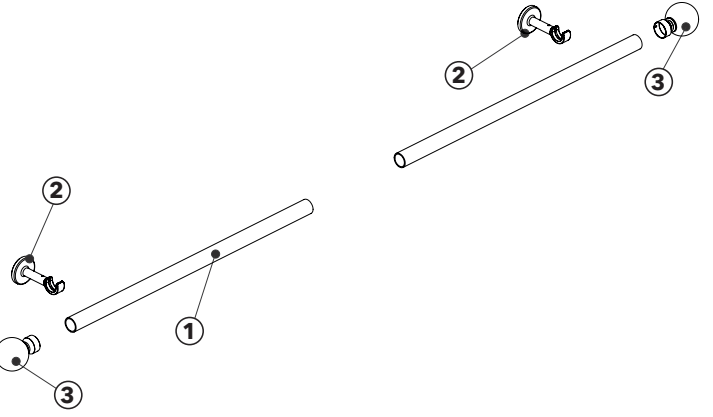


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Exploded Diagram

Getting Started

Extendable Metal Eyelet Pole

A. Check you have received all parts supplied listed and the correct quantity of each. Beware that sometimes parts are packaged within the product so not immediately visible after opening.

B. Please check the installation guide section for more details. If anything is missing, stop installing the product and contact our customer service team.

C. Check all parts are intact and undamaged. Any issues, contact our customer service team.

D. Check you have the right tools for the job. Required tools which are not provided are listed overleaf. If you are unsure of how to use these tools, please contact a professional tradesperson. We recommend Airtasker as an easy way to find trades people in your local area.

E. Ensure that all wall plugs and screws provided are suitable for your type of wall/window.

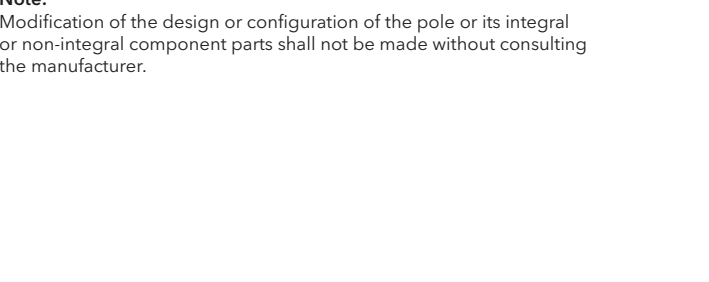
F. We recommend two people to fit longer length poles 240cm and above.

Getting Started



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Wall Fixing Guide

Important

When drilling into walls always check there are no hidden wires or pipes etc. Make sure that the screws and wall plugs being used are suitable for supporting your blind. If you are unsure of the below guidance, consult a qualified tradesperson for advice or help.

Hints

A. General Rule; Always use a larger screw and wall plug if you are not sure.

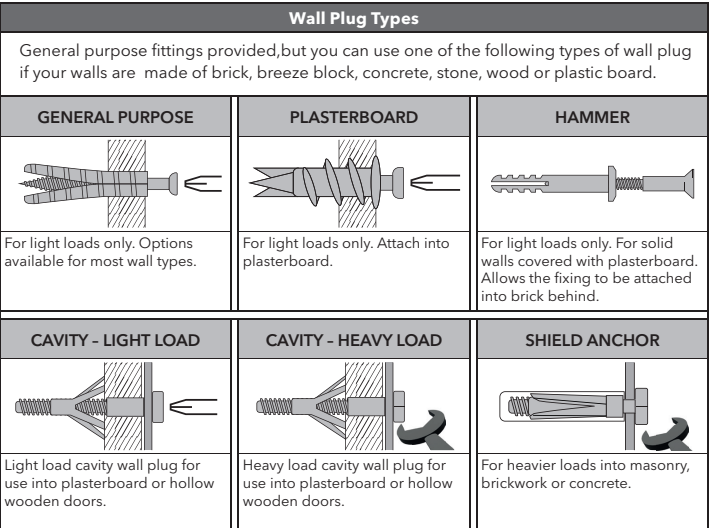
B. Ensure you use the recommended drill bit to match the wall plug and hole size.

C. Ensure you drill the hole horizontally, do not force the drill or enlarge the hole.

D. Take extra care when drilling high walls, ceilings and ceramic tiles. Ensure the plug is fitted below the ceramic tile to avoid splitting or cracking.

E. Ensure wall plugs are well fitted and are a tight fit in the drilled hole.

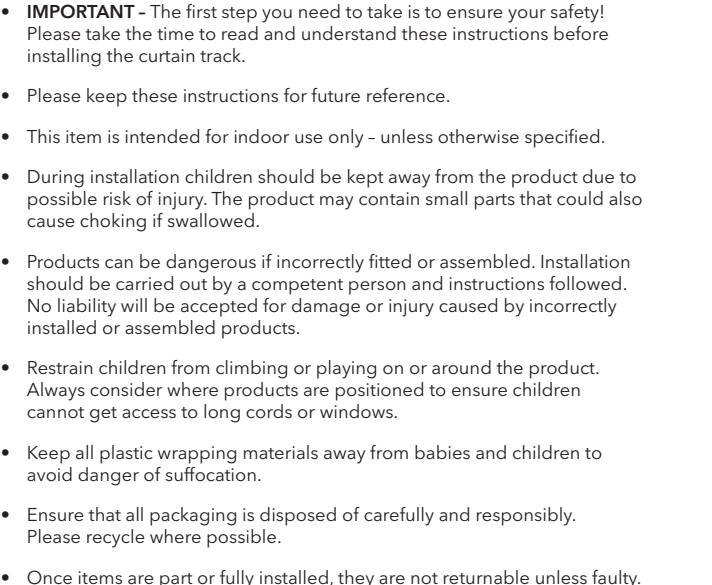
Dear customer

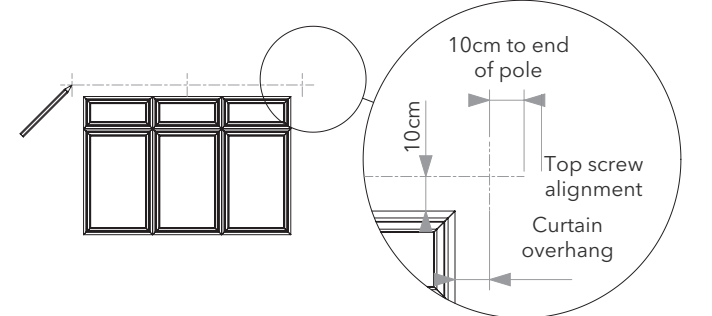
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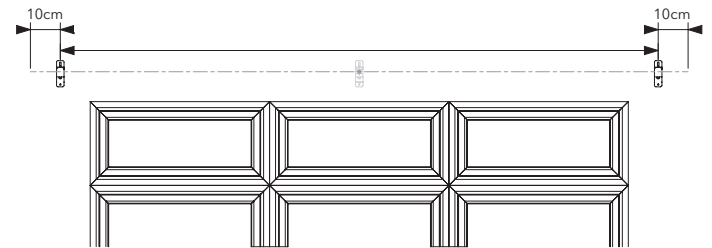
Installation Guide

Step 1 - Positioning the brackets:

Mark a line where the bracket's top screw will be. This is usually around 10cm above and 10cm to the side of the window. A pole over 120cm will need a centre bracket, position this in the middle of the pole's length. The installation should be centred with the window if possible.



Please note: Always leave 10cm either side of the end brackets for the finial to be placed.

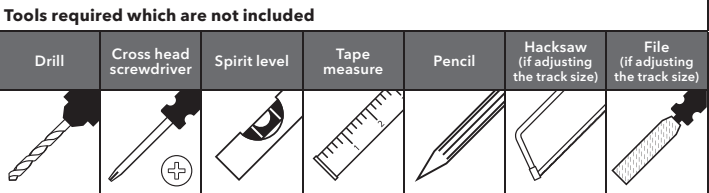

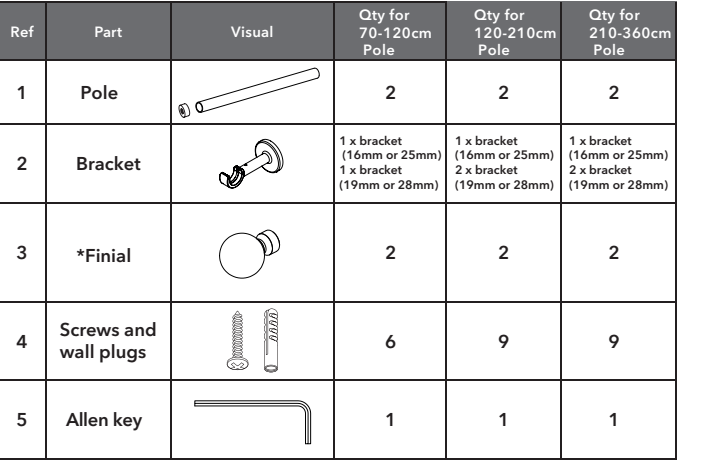

Rings are available to purchase separately, use 1 ring per 10cm of pole ensuring an equal amount of rings are used for each curtain

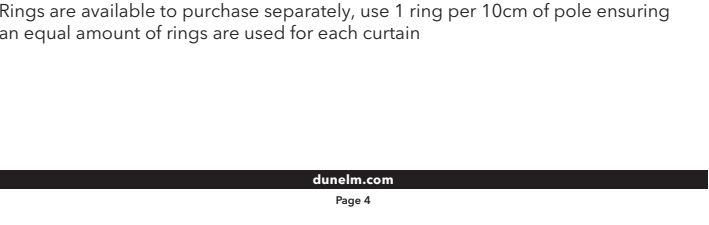

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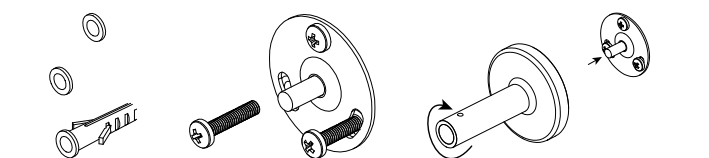

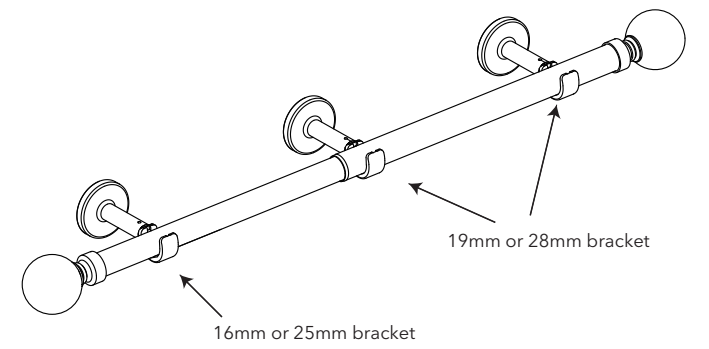
Step 2 - Fixing the bracket plates:

Note: Use the correct wall plugs and screws for your wall type. If you are unsure, please consult your local builder's merchant or DIY store.

Find the quick fit bracket's fixing plate (as shown in the diagram). This can be used as a template to ensure the holes are aligned in the right place. Use the mark made in Step 1 as a guide and align this with the top hole of the fixing plate. Once you're happy with this position, mark the other holes and drill using the appropriate fixings. Ensure the screws are fully tightened. Screw the cover plate onto the fixing plating.



Please note: There will be 1 bracket for the smaller diameter pole. Ensure this is in correct position before proceeding.



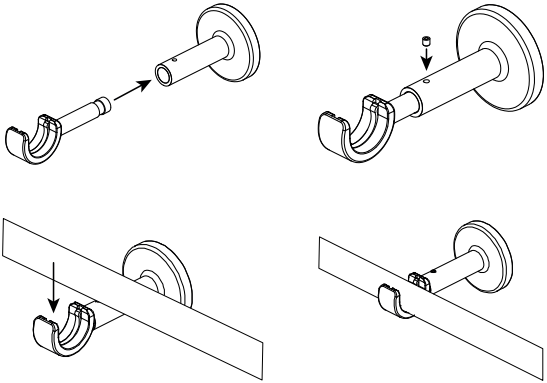
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Step 3 - Fixing the bracket arms:

Push bracket's arm into the cover. Tighten the grub screw using the Allen Key provided. The brackets length can be adjusted if necessary. Push the pole into the cup until you hear a click.

Note: the smaller diameter pole should be inserted into bracket with 16mm sticker or 25mm sticker.
