


## **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION KINGBURY BENCH**

## Please retain this information with your proof of purchase for future reference

We recommend reading through the instructions first before you start.

- 1 2 persons to assemble the unit and lift into position
- 2 Un-wrap all the components and fittings and place on a clean surface to protect them from damage, you can use the packaging for this purpose.
- 3 Check that you have all the parts (see Parts List below) before you start.
- A Please keep the assembly tools (2). You will need these to check and re-tighten the bolts, or if you want to dismantle your furniture to store away.
- 5 Place the parts on a flat surface with cardboard underneath to prevent any scratching on the surface.
- The parts are designed to be a tight fit so a rubber mallet or soft hammer may be required to assemble the bench. We recommend using a piece of cardboard where you strike the bench to avoid any damage to the timber.
- Please make sure the pre drilled holes are free of any loose timber shavings or sawdust before starting to assemble
- During storage and delivery the bench may have been exposed to damp conditions and the timber may appear to have mold on the surface, this can easily be removed with a damp cloth
- Hand tighten screws during assembly. Once assembly is complete go back and tighten all screws securely. It is also recommended that all screws are checked periodically and tightened if required.
