

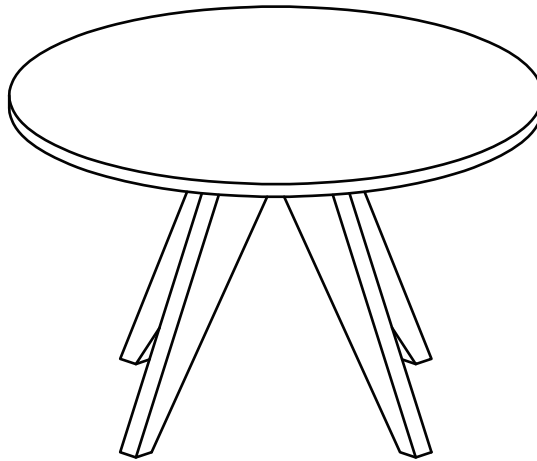

Check all screws and bolts are tightened and inspect regularly.

During severe weather conditions, including high winds, rain, hail, thunderstorms, extreme heat and cold temperatures, the product should be stored inside in a cool, dry place.

To best preserve this product, please use a protective cover when your furniture is not in use. We would also recommend using a gazebo or parasol over your furniture during the summer period and prolonged sunny spells. This will help prevent harmful UV rays from damaging and discolouring the material.

Timber is a natural product and contains coloured resins which may initially bleed out of the timber when its gets wet. Therefore we recommend that care is taken to protect patios and decking from possible staining where the product comes into contact with the ground. The furniture will stabilise in its environment after the first few times it gets wet.

Wood is a natural material whose appearance will deteriorate when left outside. A surface coating is vital in protecting it from premature darkening, or splitting, when exposed to the weather. The finish should be regularly maintained to ensure that the wood is protected from moisture and the furniture continues to look at its best.

This product has been treated with furniture oil during manufacture and the wood requires further treatment before being left out side. When applying furniture oil particular care should be given to the end grain and any joints or crevices, please note that is the products needs to be put together the first coat should be applied to all wood surfaces before assembly.

Should you choose not to treat your furniture, then it will turn a greyish colour and develop cracks. Light sanding can restore the original colour after which furniture oil can be regularly applied in accordance with the instructions above.

A liberal coating of furniture oil should be given to the furniture before it is laid up, and again when it is removed from storage.

Clean your product with a sponge and warm soapy water then wipe with a

clean, dry cloth.

Ensure that the product is clean and dry before storage.

Where instructions as to the; storage, commissioning, installation, use and maintenance of the goods or (if there is none) good trade practice are not followed and a defect arises this will void the 12 month manufacturer's guarantee on the product.













### Tips:

**It is best not to fully tighten the screws and bolts until they are all correctly located.**

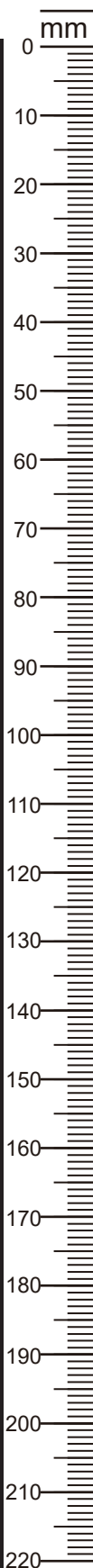
**Only carefully tighten them when you are satisfied with the alignment of all components.**

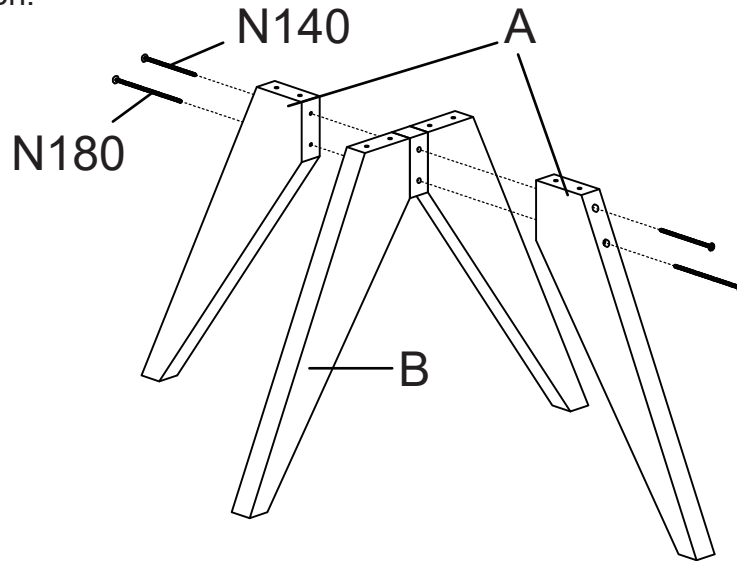
## Step by step assembly instructions

### Step One

With the help of another person, attach the Table Legs (A) to the Table Leg (B) using Bolts (N140) and Bolts (N180). Please note the Different Location of Bolts (N140& N180).

Tighten all Bolts with Allen Key (AK).

Do Not Over Tighten.

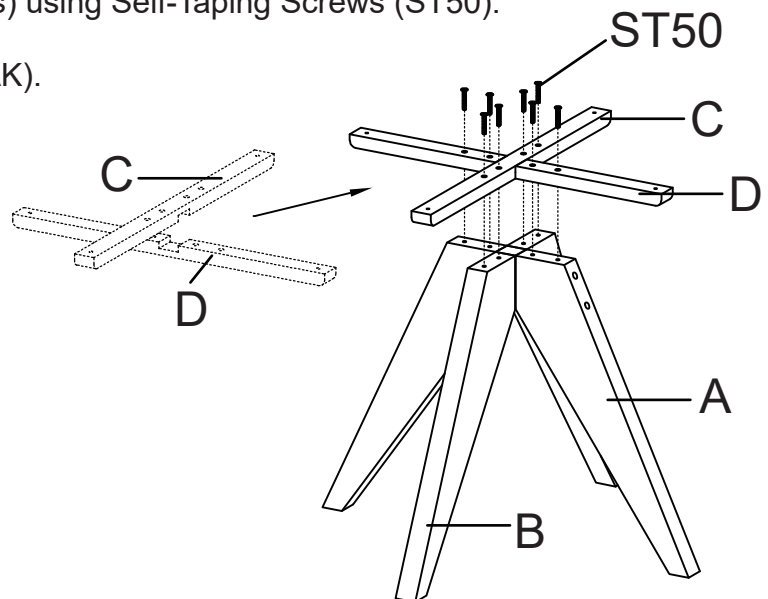


### Step Two

Attach the Upper Connecting Bar (C) and Lower Connecting Bar (D) to the above partly-assembled components (Legs) using Self-Taping Screws (ST50).

Tighten all Screws with Allen Key (AK).

Do Not Over Tighten.

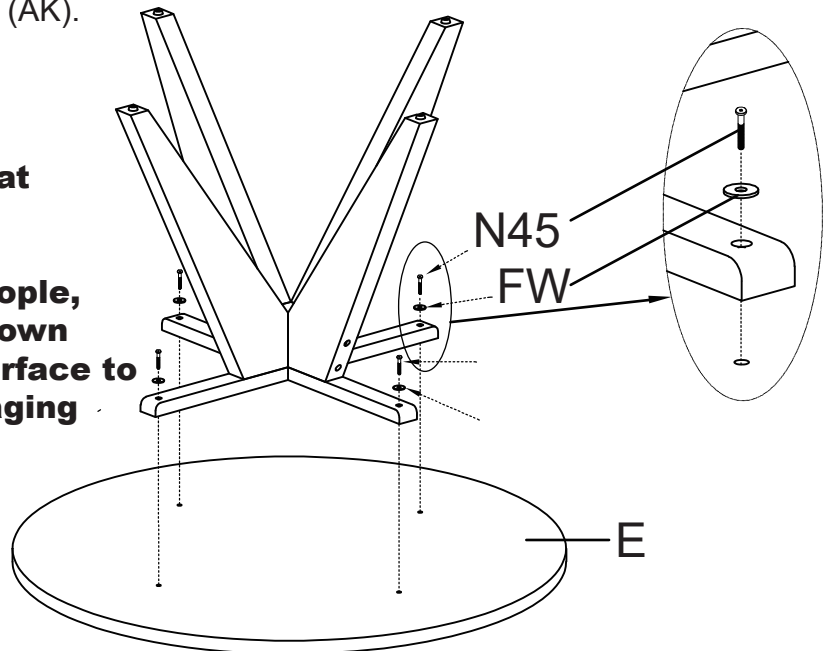


### Step Three

Attach the above Assembled Components (Let's call Table Base) to the Table Top (E) using Bolts (N45) and Flat Washers (FW).  
Tighten all Bolts with Allen Key (AK).  
Do Not Over Tighten.

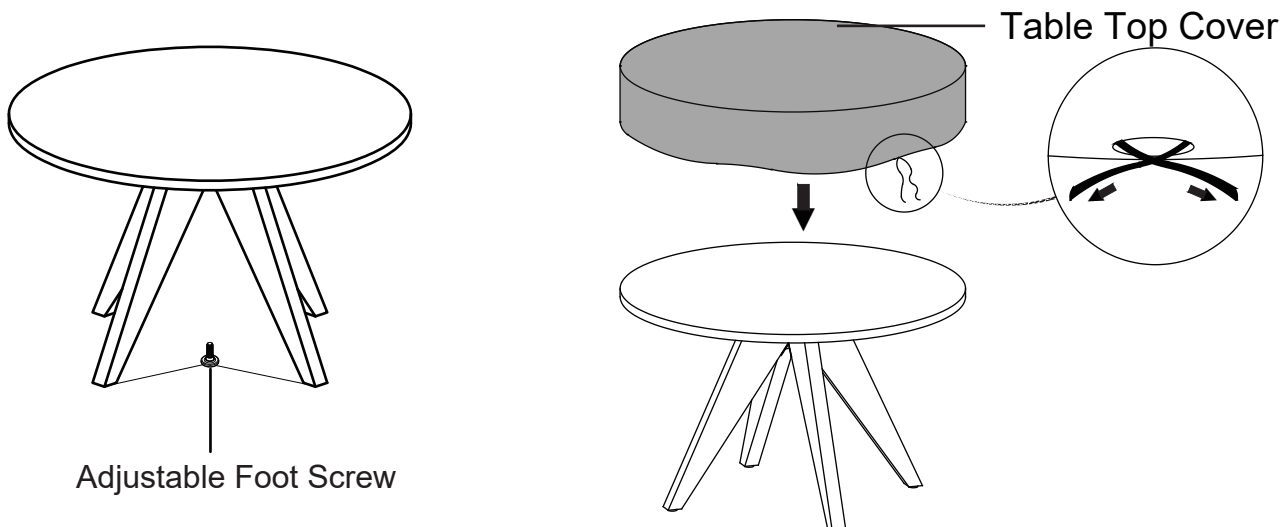


### Step Four

With the help of another person or more people, stand the table and level it with Adjustable Feet Screws.

Your Table is now ready for use.

**Always use Table Top Cover (H) to protect the Table Top when the Table is not in use.**

## **CARE INSTRUCTIONS (CONCRETE TABLE TOP)**

### **For Daily Care:**

Clean the concrete surfaces with a soft damp cloth and mild detergent or anti-bacterial household cleaning wipes.

Do not use any harsh cleaners or abrasives. Avoid any spillages & wipe off the surface immediately, do not allow to settle. Remove any excess rain water that settled on the Table Top.

### **During Autumn Time:**

In Autumn when leaves start falling from trees, special care should be used to remove leaves to avoid risk of leaf sap, which may stain your Table top.

### **Handling Product:**

Please follow the assembly instructions carefully. Please take special care to avoid risk of damage to components during assembly.

When moving your items, please lift the furniture off the floor safely to a new location.

Do not drag items on the floor or hard surfaces.

Do not stand on the furniture for your own safety & risk damage to your furniture.

Our furniture is made for domestic use.

Avoid putting hot items directly on the furniture surface, we recommend using heat resistant place mats & coasters to avoid the risk of damage to your items.

An outdoor furniture cover is recommended to guard against moisture and the elements. This will protect the finish & prolong the life of your furniture.

## **STEP BY STEP MAINTENANCE PROCESS (WOODEN PARTS)**

Your Furniture has already been treated at the point of manufacturing. No treatment is necessary for at least 3 Months. Only when you start to see signs of weathering, it is time then to proceed to the following maintenance steps to get your furniture looking good again.

There is no immediate need to apply treatment to the wood upon purchase, as it has already been coated during the manufacturing process. However, as the wood begins to weather over time, it is recommended to lightly sand the surface and then apply a water-based oil preservative to maintain its

appearance and protect it from the elements.

**1. Clean the Surface:** Start by cleaning the furniture to remove dust, dirt, or grease.

Use a damp cloth or mild soap solution, then wipe it dry with a clean cloth. Allow the surface to dry completely before proceeding.

**2. Sand the Surface:** Sand the wood lightly with 220-grit sandpaper to smooth out the surface and remove any old finish. This will also help the Wood Oil adhere better.

After sanding, wipe the furniture with a tack cloth to remove all dust and debris.

**3. Apply the First Coat of Wood Oil:**

1) Stir the Oil: We recommend using a clear water-based wood oil for the treatment of this furniture.

2) Apply the Oil: Using a small sponge, dab a thin, even coat of wood oil, working with the grain of the wood. Make sure to avoid drips or thick spots. If your product has rope material, do not apply any oil to this and wash it off immediately using luke-warm soapy water. If using a brush, apply in long, smooth strokes.

3) Let it Dry: Allow the first coat to dry according to the manufacturer's instructions. Typically, a water-based wood oil takes about 2 hours to dry.

**4. Sand between Coats:**

Once the first coat is dry, lightly sand the surface with 320-grit sandpaper.

Sanding between coats helps to smooth out any imperfections or dust particles and provides a better surface for the next layer.

Wipe the surface with a tack cloth after sanding to remove all dust.

**5. Apply Additional Coats:**

Apply the Second Coat: Apply a second thin coat of wood oil using the same method as before.

Repeat Sanding: After the second coat dries, sand light with 320-grit sandpaper again and wipe clean with a tack cloth. If you want a more durable finish, you can apply additional coats (typically 3-4 coats total).

**Tips:**

**Ventilation:** Ensure you're working in a well-ventilated area.

**Avoid over-brushing:** Don't over-brush the oil as it can create bubbles or streaks. Apply a thin, smooth layer and let it level out on its own.

**Drying Time:** Let each coat fully dry before applying the next.

By following these steps. You will create a professional looking finish on your hardwood furniture that enhances its durability and beauty.

## Step by step assembly instructions

### Step One

With the help of another person, attach the Front Left Leg (B), Front Right Leg (C), Rear Left Leg (D) and Rear Right Leg (E) to the Seat (A) using Washers (W), Bolts (B25) and Self-Taping Screws (ST25).

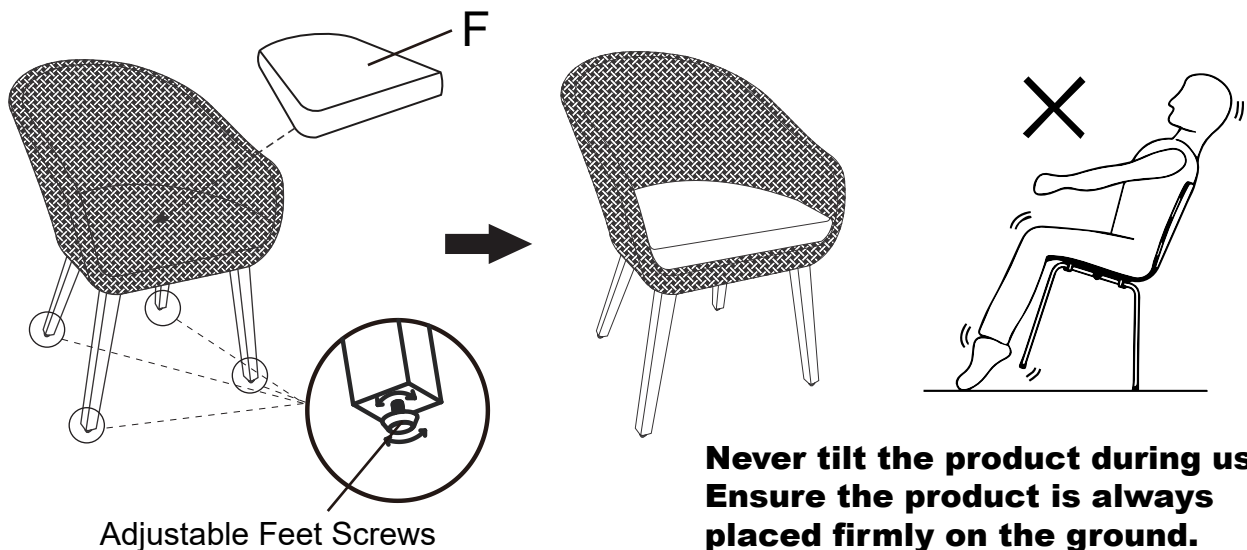
Tighten All Bolts and Screws reasonably. Do not over-tighten.



### Step Two

Stand the Chair, level the Chair with Adjustable Feet Screws under the legs. Place the Seat Cushion (F) to the Seat.

Your Chair is now ready for use.
