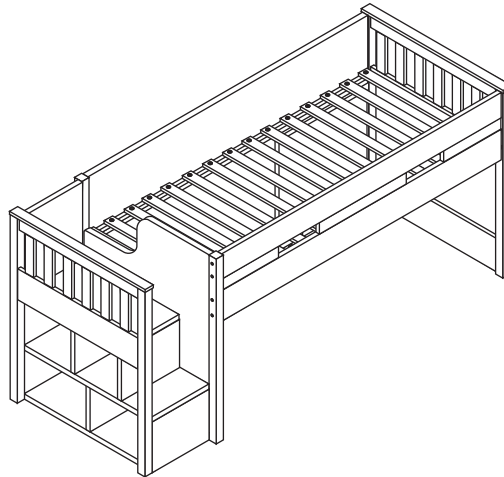
Thank you for purchasing this product. Please read through the instructions carefully before beginning assembly for this product. Before beginning assembly please check the contents of the boxes. These instructions will have a checklist for all of the parts and fittings required. To avoid damaging parts it is recommended to place a rug or carpet on the floor where it's final location to avoid having to move it. DO NOT use power tools as they may cause damage to the products.

* **WARNING :** Top Bunks and elevated Beds are dangerous and are not recommended for children under the age of 6.

The upper bunk must be more than 2 m from any ceiling fan.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. This bunk bed is suitable for a single mattress or foam bed 900mm x 1900mm. Thickness of mattress should not exceed 180mm.
2. Children should be discouraged from playing on this bunk bed.
3. The bunk bed should be checked periodically by the owner to ensure that the guardrail, ladder and other components are maintained in the correct position and state of repair and that all connectors are tight.
4. A bunk bed is not to be placed near a ceiling fan unless the distance between the closest points on the ceiling fan and bunk bed is at least 2 meters.
5. Use guardrails on both sides of upper bunk.
6. Prohibit horseplay on or under bed(s).
7. Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
8. Use ladder for entering and leaving upper bunk.
9. If the bunk bed will be placed next to the wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.
10. Fall from elevated beds can be fatal and death have occurred where children have fallen from elevated beds. This is relevant for all ages. The risk is greater for younger children.
The risk of injury or death from a fall from an elevated bed compared to a non elevated bed is :
10 x greater for 7-8 year olds
7 x greater for 9-10 year olds
3 x greater for 11-12 year olds

11. Top Bunks and elevated Beds are dangerous and are not recommended for children under the age of 6.

12. Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed for example, but not limited to hook, belt, and jump ropes.

D Montageanleitung

WICHTIG - AUFMERKSAM LESEN - ZUR SPATEREN EINSICHTNAHME AUFZUBEWAHREN

a) **WARNUNG** Hochbetten und das obere Bett bei Etagenbetten sind wegen des Verletzungsrisikos durch Stürze nicht für Kinder unter sechs Jahren geeignet.

b) **WARNUNG** Wenn sie nicht richtig verwendet werden, können Hochbetten und Etagenbetten ein schweres Verletzungsrisiko durch Strangulierung darstellen. Es dürfen niemals Elemente an Teilen des Hochbetts befestigt oder aufgehängt werden, die nicht zur Verwendung mit besagtem Bett bestimmt sind. Diese Elemente umfassen, sind aber nicht beschränkt auf, Seile, Fäden, Schnüre, Haken, Gurtel und Taschen.

c) **WARNUNG** Kinder können sich zwischen dem Bett und einer Wand, einer gekippten Wandstelle, der Decke, Möbeln in der Nähe (zum Beispiel Schranke) oder anderem einklemmen. Um jedes Risiko einer schweren Verletzung zu vermeiden, darf der Abstand zwischen der oberen Sicherheitsschranke und den Elementen in der Umgebung 75 mm nicht überschreiten oder muss größer als 230 mm sein.

EN Assembling instructions

IMPORTANT - READ CAREFULLY - KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

a) **WARNING** Raised beds and the upper bed in a bunk bed assembly are not good for children under 6 years old because of the risk of injury from falling from such beds.

b) **WARNING** If the raised and bunk beds are not used correctly, they can present a serious risk of injury from strangulation. Never attach or suspend things from the upper bunk bed that are not going to be used with that bed. Such things include - but are not limited to - cords, string, sashes, hooks, belts and bags.

c) **WARNING** Children can find themselves trapped between the bed and wall, or inclined roof wall, ceiling, adjacent pieces of furniture (such as cupboard) or other items. To avoid any risk of serious injury, the distance between the upper safety barrier and surrounding items should not exceed 75 mm - or the distance should be greater than 230 mm.

d) **WARNING** Do not use the upper bunk bed or a raised bed if a part of the structure is missing or broken. Spare parts should be requested from the manufacturer or shop.

e) It is essential that the manufacturer's instructions on assembly and use are followed.

f) The recommended size of the mattress to be used with the bed is 1900 mm x 900 mm. Maximum mattress thickness: 180 mm.

g) Mattresses must be aired to maintain a low humidity and to stop moisture building up in the bed and its surroundings.

k) The fastenings put in place on assembly should all be properly tightened and regularly checked. Retighten the fastenings as necessary.

l) This complies with the requirements of the European Safety Standard EN 747-1:2012+A1: 2015.

m) The presence of a night light could give more safety for a child sleeping in an upper bed.
