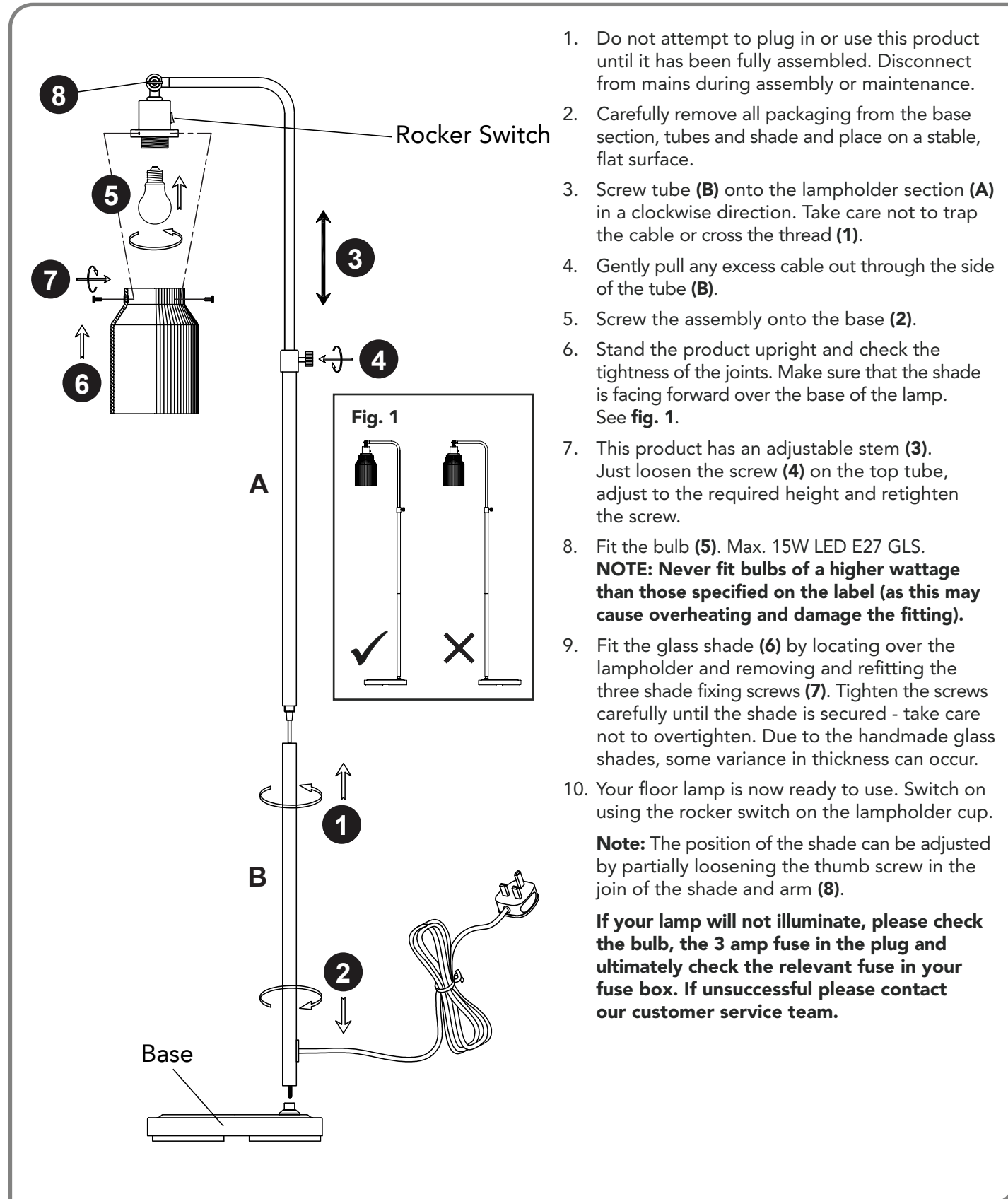


# Assembly Instructions

You have your fittings in place, and tools at the ready, so let's begin



1. Do not attempt to plug in or use this product until it has been fully assembled. Disconnect from mains during assembly or maintenance.
2. Carefully remove all packaging from the base section, tubes and shade and place on a stable, flat surface.
3. Screw tube (B) onto the lampholder section (A) in a clockwise direction. Take care not to trap the cable or cross the thread (1).
4. Gently pull any excess cable out through the side of the tube (B).
5. Screw the assembly onto the base (2).
6. Stand the product upright and check the tightness of the joints. Make sure that the shade is facing forward over the base of the lamp. See fig. 1.
7. This product has an adjustable stem (3). Just loosen the screw (4) on the top tube, adjust to the required height and retighten the screw.
8. Fit the bulb (5). Max. 15W LED E27 GLS.  
**NOTE: Never fit bulbs of a higher wattage than those specified on the label (as this may cause overheating and damage the fitting).**
9. Fit the glass shade (6) by locating over the lampholder and removing and refitting the three shade fixing screws (7). Tighten the screws carefully until the shade is secured - take care not to overtighten. Due to the handmade glass shades, some variance in thickness can occur.
10. Your floor lamp is now ready to use. Switch on using the rocker switch on the lampholder cup.  
**Note:** The position of the shade can be adjusted by partially loosening the thumb screw in the join of the shade and arm (8).  
**If your lamp will not illuminate, please check the bulb, the 3 amp fuse in the plug and ultimately check the relevant fuse in your fuse box. If unsuccessful please contact our customer service team.**

## Safety and Care Advice

**IMPORTANT** - The first step you need to take is to ensure your safety! Please take the time to read and understand these instructions before assembling your light, and retain for future reference.

- This product is only suitable for connection to a 240V~50Hz supply in accordance with current IEE Wiring Regulations. It is for indoor use only, and not suitable for a bathroom location.
- This fitting is a Class II, double insulated symbol product. It does not require an Earth, and Live or Neutral must not be connected to Earth.
- The lamp must be protected by a 3 amp fuse in the mains plug. Do not plug into the mains until your lamp is fully assembled. This product is not suitable for persons under 14 years of age.
- Under no circumstances must this table lamp be covered with any material as this could pose a safety hazard. It must be used on a stable, flat surface.
- When manoeuvring or assembling this product, it must be lifted from the bottom section.
- Never fit bulbs of a higher wattage than those specified on the label, as these may cause overheating and damage the fitting.
- If the mains cable becomes damaged it must only be replaced by a technically competent, qualified person.
- This product contains delicate parts – be careful during handling and maintenance to avoid breakage.
- If you are in any doubt about your competence please consult a qualified electrician.
- If any modification is made it will invalidate the warranty and may render the product unsafe.
- Keep children and animals away from the assembly area.
- This fitting contains small parts that could cause choking if swallowed.
- Keep all plastic wrapping materials away from children to avoid danger of suffocation.
- Ensure that all packaging is disposed of carefully and responsibly.

## Care and Maintenance Advice


In order to prevent damage or wear to your fitting, take care to ensure the following:

Allow 10 minutes to cool before replacing, adjusting or cleaning.

Clean with a dry cloth only. In order to preserve the finish, do not use liquid or abrasive cleaners on this product.

Glass parts - Remove and wash in warm water or just use a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive materials as these will damage the finish. Take care when handling glass parts to avoid damage or injury.

Our packaging is recyclable, please recycle where facilities exist.

 Waste electrical products should not be disposed of with household waste. Please recycle where facilities exist. Check with your Local Authority or retailer for recycling advice.

**We're happy to recycle your old light for free. Simply bring it to store within 28 days of purchase of your new light, with your receipt, and we'll make sure your old light stays out of landfill.**
