Slight chips along cut tile edges should be expected.

ASSEMBLY During assembly, be careful not to pinch your fingers.

- 1. Lay the tabletop face down on a soft surface to avoid scratching
- 2. Open the leg assembly, which is hinged
- 3. Place the 3 holes in the top of the leg assembly onto the 3 bolts protruding from the underside of the tabletop
- 4. Screw on the 3 domed head nuts provided, hand-tight only until all 3 nuts are in position
- 5. Finally, tighten the 3 nuts with a spanner (do not use a socket set or power tools). Do not over-tighten, as this could cause the bolts to shear
- 6. Carefully lift the table and turn on to its feet

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE: 1. Periodically check the fittings are tight 2. Do not stand on the table

3. Use the product only on flat and level surfaces 4. Ensure the table is stable.

This table is intended for private and domestic use only.

CARE, MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE: clean with mild soap and water; do not use bleach, acid, or abrasive cleaners. The table must be protected from frost. Any chips to the metalwork should be touched up using enamel paint to avoid rust. The tiles are durable but may chip or crack if heavy items are dropped on them. We suggest that placemats are used when you put very hot items on the table. Although the tiles are resistant to staining, the grout may stain, and spills should be removed as soon as possible.
