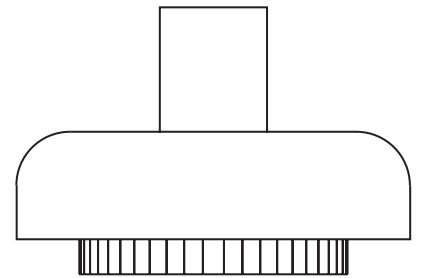


Floyd Easy Fit Pendant

Assembly & Care Instructions



Getting Started

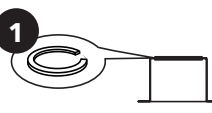
1. Check you have received all parts listed and the correct quantity of each. Beware that sometimes parts are packaged within the product so not immediately visible after opening. Please check the assembly section for more details. If anything is missing, stop assembling the product and contact our customer service team.
2. Check all parts are intact and undamaged. Any issues, stop assembling the product and contact our customer service team.

Safety Advice

Dear Customer

- **IMPORTANT** - The first step you need to take is to ensure your safety! Please take the time to read and understand these instructions before assembling the product.
- Please keep these instructions for future reference.
- Ensure that your pendant wiring is clamped correctly both in the ceiling and in the lampholder, and that the cable is in good condition. We recommend that it is at least 100mm in length.
- This fitting can be fitted to either a E27/ES or a B22/BC type lampholder by using the shade reducer ring.
- Before installing your light fitting always switch off the mains supply and remove the appropriate fuse or switch off the appropriate circuit breaker before commencing installation.
- If you are in any doubt about your competence please consult a qualified electrician.
- You may find it easier to install with the help of an assistant.
- This product is for indoor use only, and not suitable for a bathroom location.
- This product has been packaged as separate parts to prevent damage during transit.
- This product contains glass so care must be taken when fitting or handling to prevent personal injury or damage to the product.
- For your safety, always switch off the supply before cleaning or changing the bulb.
- Never fit bulbs of a higher wattage than those specified on the label, as these may cause overheating and damage the fitting.
- If any modification is made it will invalidate the warranty and may render the product unsafe.
- Keep children and animals away from the assembly area.
- Ensure that all packaging is disposed of carefully and responsibly. Please recycle where possible.

Assembly Instructions

Step 1

Unpack the shade and familiarise yourself with the parts provided.

Step 2

To assemble the shades, fit the top metal tube (E) to the top of the outer glass shade (D). Fit the acrylic disk (C) to the top of the inner glass shade (B) and place inside the outer shade.

Step 3

Fitting to a B22/BC lampholder.

If your existing pendant lampholder is a standard bayonet lampholder (B22/BC) the shade reducer ring (1) inside the lamp cup (A) will need to be fitted to reduce the hole size.

Place the assembly over the lampholder and fit the lamp cup to secure in place. Tighten with light pressure.

Fitting to a E27/ES lampholder.

If your existing pendant lampholder is an Edison Screw (E27/ES) or a specialist lampholder there is no need to use the shade reducer ring. It should still be kept in case the pendant is moved to another lampholder.

Place the assembly over the lampholder and fit the lamp cup to secure in place.

If the lamp cup doesn't fit, it may be necessary to fit the supplied narrow shade ring (F). Use the shade ring tool (G) supplied. Tighten with light pressure.

Periodically check the secure fit of the shades.

Step 4

Fit the bulb (2). Max 15W LED E27 or B22 GLS.

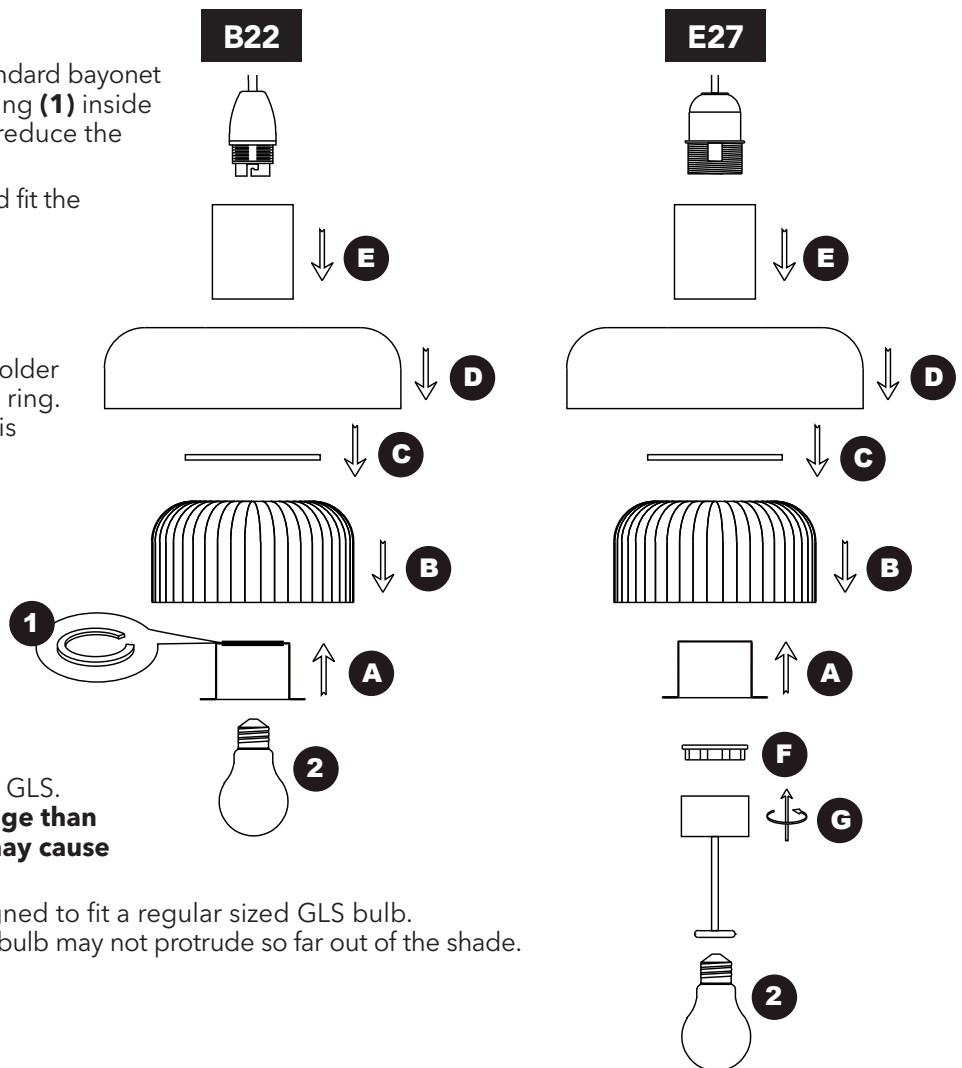
NOTE: Never fit bulbs of a higher wattage than those specified on the label (as these may cause overheating and damage the fitting).

Please note: This product has been designed to fit a regular sized GLS bulb.

For the best aesthetic look a lower wattage bulb may not protrude so far out of the shade.

Step 5

Turn on and test.



Care and Cleaning

Finish - We recommend cleaning with a soft dry cloth. Do not use abrasive materials as these will damage the finish.

Glass parts - Remove and wash in warm water or just use a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive materials as these will damage the finish. Take care when handling glass parts to avoid damage or injury.

Our packaging is recyclable, please recycle where facilities exist.
